No more tears

Let me tell you a story... I met Tami when I was first convicted. I was in solitary confinement, because the media about my case was so insane. I would look out my window and watch all of the ladies downstairs. One day I noticed this young girl. She looked so young and impressionable. I wondered if she was even old enough to be there. I began to pray for her. She got the job of bringing food to us and I found out she was barely 17. She was charged as an adult and soon moved to a youth offender program until the day she turned 18. It was 52 degrees in my steel and cement cell and I was freezing. When she left the county jail she was wearing the only sweatshirt in the jail and kindly gave it to me. Soon God moved us both to the maximum security prison, where we would spend the next years of our lives. She was in the bed directly across from mine. I mothered her

a lot. At that time she wasn't interested in Jesus, but was in desperate need of His love. We became good friends! She got out months before my case was overturned and went back to Corpus. She had to do 90 days in county jail for a parole violation. At this same time, I was moved back to county, because my case has been overturned and I was awaiting a hearing for my release. The cell I was put in was covered in feces, causing me to get very sick with an infection. She broke the rules and begged the officers to take care of me. She probably saved my life! While she was taking care of me, she pondered why she was there. She began to see that God had worked out every detail for a reason and she made the choice to trust Him with her life. She still struggled as she dealt with a lot of pain. She had a beautiful baby boy named Alex, and asked us to be his Godparents. I asked her, "What does that mean to you?" She said it meant that we would love him, help teach him about God, and help take care of him if ever

she couldn't. We had Alex with us several times while Tami was moving or looking for a job. Our kids have an amazing love and connection with him. In February, while Alex was visiting with us, my sweet friend passed away. It's hard not to wonder if she'd still be here if the Syndeo home was up and running, but the Bible tells us in Psalm 139:16, "... all the days ordained for me were written in your book before one of them came to be." Larry had the honor of officiating at her funeral and the Syndeo team along Calvary Chapel Coastlands were blessed to be able to minister by providing food and hopefully some comfort in such a difficult time. We are taking our commitment to Tami to be Alex' Godparents seriously, and will help his grandma however she sees fit. We will all miss Tami, but are so grateful for the blessing of getting to know her and getting to see first hand how Jesus held her close and began to heal her heart. No more tears!
